HISTORY

At the conclusion of the World War II, after 50 years of Japanese imperialistic rule, Taiwan was finally returned to the Government of the Republic of China. The country was suffering from neglect and needed to be rebuilt. It was during this time, that our KMT Government was actively involved in the development of a women's movement.

Under the encouragement of the government, women from all over the country began mobilizing and a 300 women strong organization was developed. On May 16, 1946, Yu-Li Chen, Yu-Ying Liu, E-Hsieh and Shi-Sien Shu organized the first meeting in Taipei with E-Hsieh as the first chairperson of the board. The Taiwan Provincial Women Association was founded. Cities, counties, towns, and township nationwide had established a Women Association. The Taiwan Provincial Women Association changed its name to Women's Association of the Republic of China on October 16, 2001. Currently there are women's associations in 25 cities and counties and in 368 townships and towns with 620,000 members.

After 66 years of establishment a deep foundation was founded with the effort of several terms of chairmen, directors, and various cadres and services rendered by enthusiastic members in the society. But after more than 60 years of stable living and with the trend of the world, we need to show more concern and love to our society during the transition period of promoting political reformation by linking family structure to show our love for our family, town, and country.

STRUCTURE OF ORGANNIZATION AND MEMBERSHIP

Using townships, towns, cities and districts as organization unit, its members are considered as an individual member. Township, town, city, and district women associations call for a delegate convention according to the administrative district and conduct election of directors. County and city representatives who attended the member convention elect directors and nationwide representatives forming the county/ city women association. Nationwide members shall attend the nationwide convention and elect directors to form the Women's Association Headquarter of the Republic of China.

Member representatives of the convention are the highest power organization. Under it is the Board of Directors and Board of Supervisors. There are 35 directors, 11 supervisors, and 11 standing committee in the board. The board elects a board chairman from the standing committee and chairman of the board nominates 1 or 2 persons from the standing committee as vice chairperson(s). The Board of Supervisors has 3 standing supervisors who shall elect a chairman of supervisor who shall be in charge of managing the daily business of the Board of Supervisors. The term of office of the board members is 3 years and the chairperson can only be reelected for one consecutive term.

The Association has one executive secretary who shall set up a general affairs section, section training, cultural and religion section. Each section has 1 leader with several staff, and one warden for the women's dormitory.
